EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING - July 12, 1977

The TRW ARC Executive Committee meeting was called to order in room M2-1825 at 12:01 PM by the president. The following people were present: President Bill Dews, K6AWO, Vice President Ted Carter, WA6PAS, Secretary Jim Hill, W6IVW, Cross Talk Editor Mac McGrew, K6RL, and Assistant Editor Mel Erb, K6GWC. Bill presented those present with a 15 point agenda - but many of the subjects had to be tabled as the key people were not present. The agenda is listed below:

1. Need a Radiogram for F. D. Report
Tabled, as Cartier not present.
2. Swap meet date, (chairperson Schrecengost)
Tentatively scheduled for the second weekend in October. (Additional information elsewhere in Cross Talk).
3. November F. D. awards dinner chairperson/date
Partially tabled as Cartier not present. Possible speakers discussed, and Jim Hill will get additional information on possible speaker from ham legal aid group. (Should anyone have ideas regarding a speaker, please contact Bill Dews or Frank Cartier. It is difficult to find a speaker that will interest both hams and their wives)
4. Vice President Name
Discussed, but still need someone. (Say, those of you who bad mouth the club regarding it being run by a clique, here's your chance! Volunteer yourself or another person - with the person's approval, of course. Tell me, and I will submit it. I have not worked at TRW long enough to qualify as a member of the clique).
5. Letter to ARRL about F. D. DUP log?
Bill will write a letter to the ARRL about problems with their duplication log form.
6. TRW/ARC membership list Halligan
The new system is about ready to go. He needs address information for Dave Carson, Bob Goad, Herb Gleed, and Chuck Davis.
7. Training Program (Cooper) date
Tabled, as Cooper is on vacation.
8. Treasure Bank Check Signing Card. Carter
There was a misunderstanding regarding proper signatures, and some checks bounced. The proper signatures have been obtained, and any two of the following are required: Dew, Carter, Heydon, Komatsu. New checks are required; don't resubmit old checks.
9. LAACARC next meeting date, person
Meetings are held on the first Tuesday, bi-monthly, so the next meeting will be September 6. Jim Hill had planned to attend, but he will be on vacation at that time.

10. F. D. \$ Report Cartier \$
Cartier was not present, but it is understood that the total expenses are a little above \$107.84. \$110 is probably a good estimate.
11. Door Prize and July 27 Speaker (Cartier)
Per the present method of allocating monies for door prizes, \$27 is available for the meeting. No further discussion, as Cartier was absent.
12. Financial, Presser
The club presently has \$460.18, excluding Field Day costs. Everyone should check their junk boxes and garages for equipment for the next Swap Meet auction. Donations such as Bill Ivey's (WA6QET) generous assistance at the last auction are especially welcome. The fee for a selling space was discussed, and \$1.50 was tentatively considered for the next auction. Cross Talk costs average \$40 to \$50 per month.
13. TRW/ARC meeting, 7-12, 8-9, 9-13, 10-1, 11-8, 12-13
These dates are scheduled for the Executive Committee meetings. Officers and Staff: Mark your calendars to avoid possible conflicts in the future.

August 19

Tabled, as Komatsu not present.
