EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING September 12, 1978 by Jim Hill, W6IVW

The TRW ARC Executive Committee meeting was called to order in room M2-1825 at 12:06 PM by the president. The following people were present: President Bill Dews, K6AWO, Vice President Mac McGrew, K6RL, Secretary Jim Hill, W6IVW, Treasurer Bill Ivey, WA6QET, Trustee Paul Weisz, K6YQ, Activities Manager Gary Komatsu, K6HPD, and Cross Talk Editor Mel Erb, K6GWC.

- 1. SEA Activity Day
 Chairman Bill Schrek needs a co-chairman, since he has a temporary work
 assignment at Newport Beach. Komatsu was appointed co-chairman.
- September 30 Swap Meet
 Bill Ivey will serve as an interface between the ARC and SEA. More tables are required.
- Cross Talk
 Since Erb will be out of tuwn, McGrew will publish the next edition of Cross Talk.
 Final date for inputs is September 15. Postage costs are approx. \$100/year.
- 4. LAACARC
 The LAACARC is looking for someone who could serve as an expert witness in court regarding ham antennas. An expert witness is a person who provides technical information. Interested people should contact Jim Hill, x53677.
- Financial Assistance for the Schroeder Antenna Trial
 The appeal by Pete Hoover of the LAACARC for funds to help support the
 Schroeder antenna legal battle was discussed. Since the treasury is severe!
 depleted due to the purchase of the TS-820S, it was decided that we could not
 afford a contribution at this time. Individuals who wish to contribute to this
 important case should contact John Alexander, K6SVL.
- 6. Emergency Preparedness Plan
 This subject is tabled until we receive additional information from Security.
- 7. October Input to SEA

 Ivey and Komatsu will prepare this information. Weisz will also have an input.
- 8. Station Equipment
 The TS-820S has been received, and preliminary tests by Weisz indicate it is an excellent rig. Weisz will keep it until the sealed bid sale of the Swan station is completed. Woody Ornellas, AA6OO, suggested that the club buy a keyer. Funds are not available at this time, but Woody will be asked to research the subject and recommend a particular keyer.
