
# It's Convenient, It's Robust, It's COVID-Safe!

#### **Step-By-Step Process At-A-Glance**

- Study for the test(s) until you're ready to pass!
  - You can usually take more than one test in a single exam session
- Search <u>HamStudy.orq</u> for an online session
- Sign-up for a session
  - Pay (nominal) exam fee
- Read the rules of engagement
  - Understand how the VEs ensure the integrity of the testing process
- Show up on-time and be patient
  - Demand is high!
- Pass the exam (of course!)
- Sign documents (all online!)
- Celebrate!

### Finding A Session: HamStudy.org

- HamStudy.org is the clearing-house
  - Central location for testing sessions provided by many (all?) VECs offering them
- Filter search by zip code
  - You can take an online test from any offering VEC,, but pay attention to time zones
- I elected to use the Greater Los Angeles
   Amateur Radio Group VEC (GLAARG)
- Session list is oriented by date
- Demand is high!
  - Sessions with available space may be at least a few days away
  - However, lots of options to choose from



#### **GLAARG VEC**

- One of the 14 FCC-approved VECs, operating since 1984
- Administered over 2000 remote exams since April 2020
- They are not a radio club, just a VEC
- \*Lots\* of information on their website at <u>GLAARG VEC</u>
  - Testing FAQs
  - Detailed instructions
  - HamStudy.org session list, filtered for GLAARG
- All GLAARG exam session are \$10 (\$5 for youths)
  - You may take multiple exams in a single session
    - Notify them ahead of time, for planning purposes



### **Preparing For The Exam**

- Read the detailed emails you receive following registration
  - Everything is in there!
- Meet the technical requirements
  - If you can "Zoom" already, you're probably set
- Meet the "environment" requirements
  - Be ready to demonstrate that you can take the test in a "clean" environment
  - The administering VEs will walk you through an inspection of your location
- Everything is now done <u>online</u>
  - No need to send paper verification of existing licenses they look it up in the ULS
  - All application forms filled out and signed electronically at the time of the exam
- Study and be ready to pass!

### My Experience

- I took the Extra exam on a Saturday in October 2020
- As with most sessions, mine was full over 70 exams administered that day
- Despite the volume, the GLAARG team did a great job making the wait enjoyable
  - Multiple zoom "waiting rooms" setup in which "hosts" answered questions about the testing process,
     chatted about amateur radio, and generally made everyone feel welcome
- Test was continuously monitored by 3 VEs
- Three steps:
  - o Confirm identity DL, existing license, etc.
  - Confirm security of test environment video "tour" that no unapproved testing "aids" are within reach/view
  - Take the test VEs see everything you see/do
  - When you pass, complete and sign forms
- I saw results in the FCC ULS within a few hours!

GLAARG runs a professional remote testing program! They are experienced and dedicated to providing secure licensing to everyone, despite COVID-19.
